Proper Names of God

Elohim: OT:430, - "God": connected with God's creative power, use 2597 time in the OT.

El-Shaddai: OT:410-OT:7706, - "God Almighty" or (God All Sufficient), used 48 times in OT.

Yahweh: OT:3068, - "self Existent, Eternal God", (Jehovah), used 5000 times in the OT.

Adonai: OT:136, - "(my) Lord", {a proper name, for God only}, use 449 times in the OT.

Combining the vowels of Adonai with the consonants of Yahweh, give us: "Jehovah"

Jehovah-Shalom	OT:3073 – Gideon, called the altar, "The LORD our Peace"	Judges 6:24

Jehovah-Sabaoth	OT:3068-OT:6635 - The Lord of Hosts, (commander of the armies).	Isaiah 1:24
