Jehovah-Jireh: OT:3070 - (my Provider) Abraham called that place Jehovah-Jireh, for he said; this day in the mount, Jehovah does provide, Genesis 22:14. (1 occurrence)

Jehovah-Rapha: OT:3068 + OT:7495 – (my Healer) If thou will diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, for I am the LORD your healer, Exodus 15:26, Psalms 103:3, 147:3.

Jehovah-Nissi: OT:3071 – (my Banner / Conquer) Moses built an altar, and called the name of it Jehovah My Banner, Exodus 17:15. (1 occurrence)

Jehovah-Mekaddish: OT:3068 + OT:6942 – (He that sanctifies) ye shall keep my statutes, and do them: I *am* the LORD which sanctify you, Exodus 31:13, Leviticus 20:8, Ezekiel 37:28. (3)

Jehovah-Shalom: OT:3073 - (my Peace) Gideon built an altar there to Jehovah, and called it Jehovahshalom, Judges 6:24. (1 occurrence)

Jehovah-Sabaôth : OT:3068 + OT:6635 – (the Lord of Hosts) And the Lord, Jehovah of Hosts, the mighty One of Israel, 1<sup>st</sup> Samuel 1:3, Psalms 46:7, Isaiah 1:24, (used over 250 times).

Jehovah-Rohi: OT:3068 + OT:7462 - (my Shepherd) A Psalm of David. Jehovah is my Shepherd; I shall not want, Psalm 23:1, Isaiah 40:11, Ezekiel 34:23. (3 occurrences)

Jehovah-Tsidkenu: OT:3068 + OT:6664 (my Righteousness) And this *is* His name by which He shall be called, JEHOVAH, OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS, Jeremiah 23:6, 33:16. (2 occurrences)

Jehovah-Shammah: OT:3068 + OT:8033 - (I AM there) and the name of the city from *that* day *shall be*, The LORD *is* there, Ezekiel 48:35 (1 occurrence)

Matthew 23:9, John 20:17, Romans 8:15, Galatians 4:6, 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 1:17.

Abba: NT:5 - having Aramaic word origins of NT:2 + NT:1 - "Father + chief".

corresponding to our English words, "Daddy" or "Papa" God has revealed Himself to us and as New Testament believers, we can now have a personal relationship with Him, much more than just knowing formal Names.



## Names of God

The Old Testament Names reveals God's character, and the New Testament reveals a personal God that we can now call Abba Father.

Elohim: - God as Creator and Judge.

El-Shaddai: - God Almighty, All Sufficient.

El-Elyon: - The Most High, Supreme God.

El- Roi: - The God who sees me.

Emmanuel: - God with us.

Yahweh: - Self Existent, Eternal God.

Adonai: - "(my) Lord, Master & Owner."

Combining the vowels of Adonai with the consonants of Yahweh, gives us, "YaHoVaH", according to ancient Jewish text. Perhaps influenced by Psalm 68:4, "His name is JAH", we get.

Jehovah: - IAM, the Self Existent, Eternal God.
