## Teaching: "It's a legal matter"

Jesus paid it all, we cannot add to it, nor can we detract from it, nullify it, or deny what His finished work on the cross did for us.

However, we can fail to receive it, if we don't realize that it is legally ours.

• And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His will, He hears us: And if we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him,1<sup>st</sup> John 5:14-15.

The phrase; "hears us: is also referring to a legal hearing, Jesus paid the price, it is legally ours and it was settled 2000 years ago in a spiritual court of law.

## Then why do most people not have all that is rightly theirs?

- My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou has rejected knowledge, {Hosea 4:6}.
- The thief comes not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy:, {John 10:10}.
- when they have heard, Satan comes immediately, and takes away the Word that was sown in their hearts, {Mark 4:15}.
- Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices, 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 2:11.

Satan's only weapon against us is deception, due to our not knowing God's Word and our standing within His kingdom.

Therefore, get knowledge, get hope and receive all.

We have salvation through Jesus Christ, <u>it's a legal matter</u>. sozo (4982) = (save, deliver, protect, heal, preserve, make whole)

- And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God, Romans 12:2.
- Beloved, I wish above all things that thou may prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospers, 3<sup>rd</sup> John 1:2.

## Righteous Justice heirs of His covenant promises
